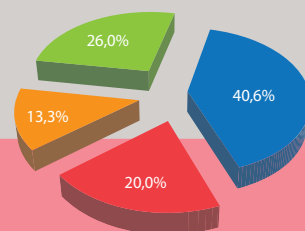

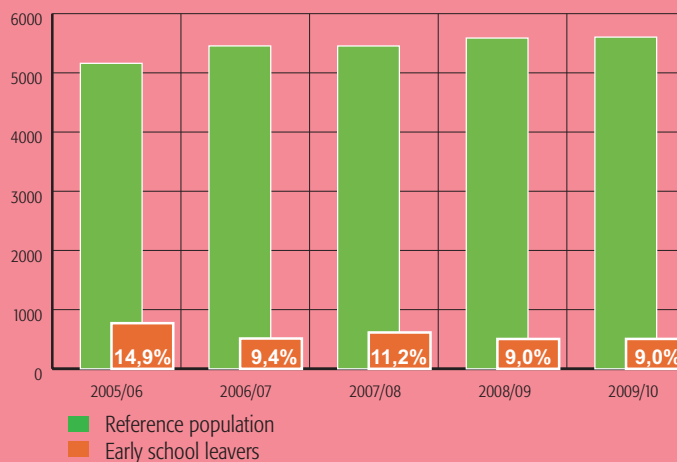


Graduation rates

The graduation rate measures the number of pupils having obtained a diploma compared with the initial number of pupils.

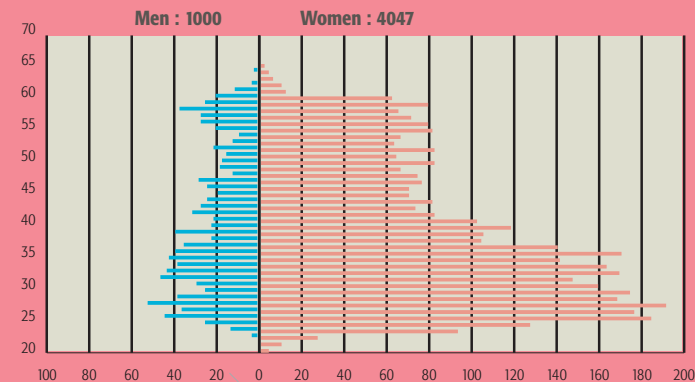

Percentage of early school leavers

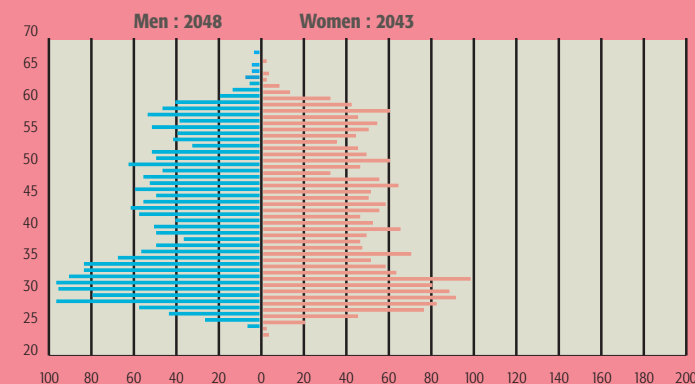

Expenditure per pupil - budget year 2009

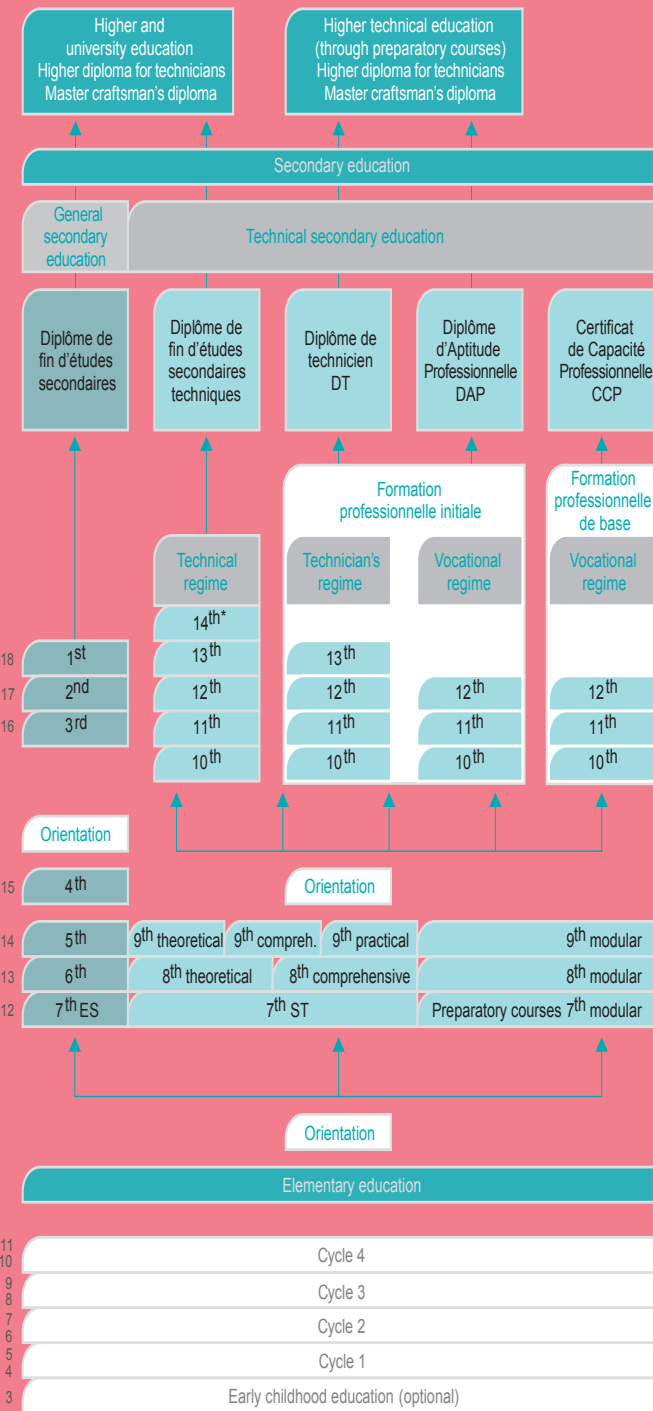

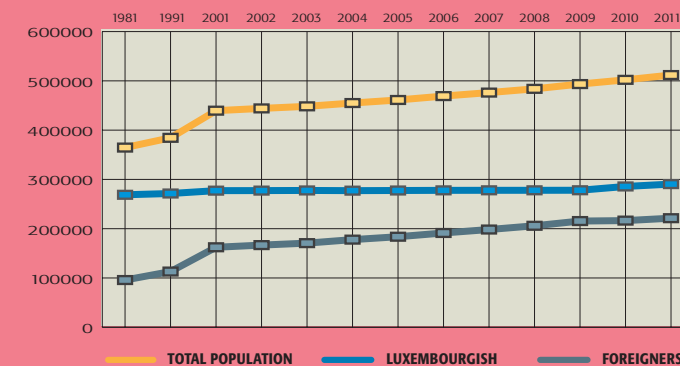

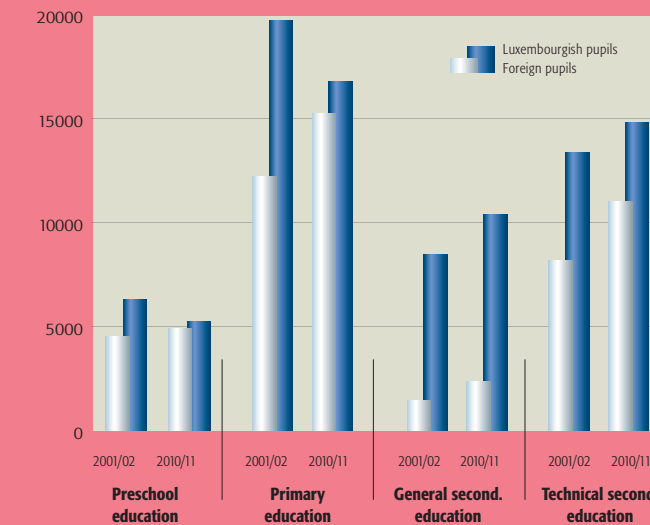
