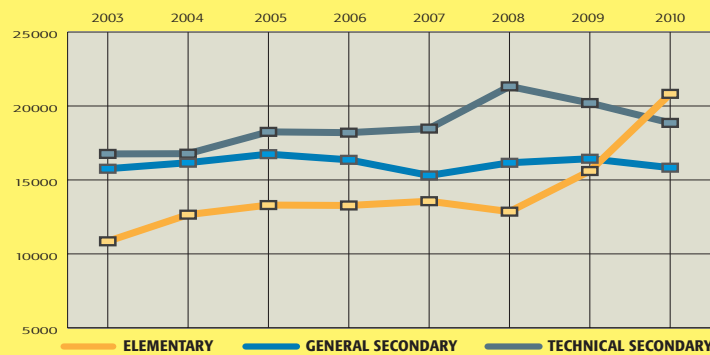
* The restructuring of studies for health professions, where exceptionally two classes (13th and 14th) took their final exam, leads in 2011/12 to an increase of 2,1%.

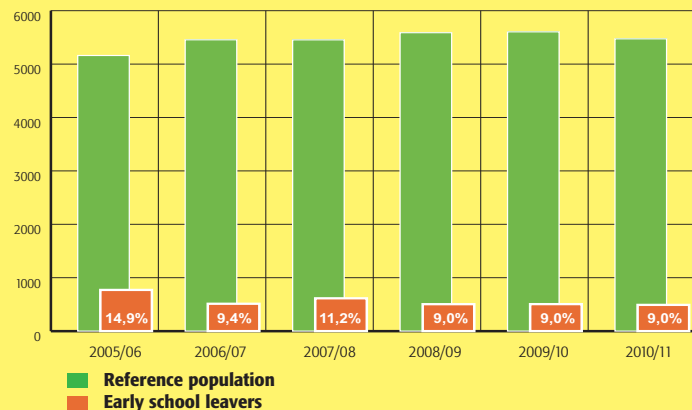

Trends in the expenditure per pupil in public schools

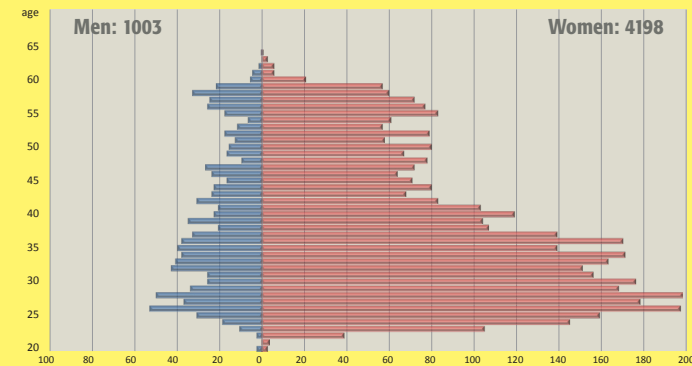


Percentage of early school leavers

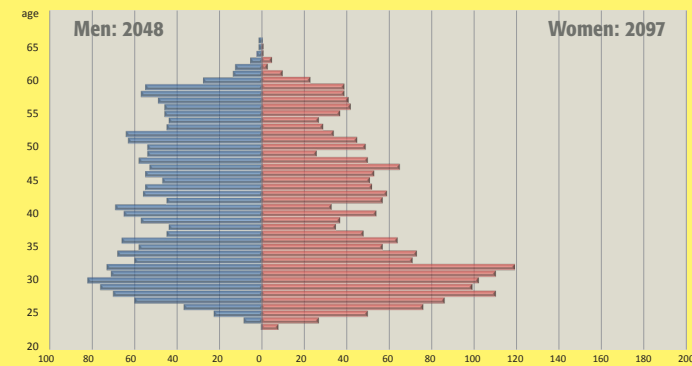


School teachers in public schools - school year 2011/12

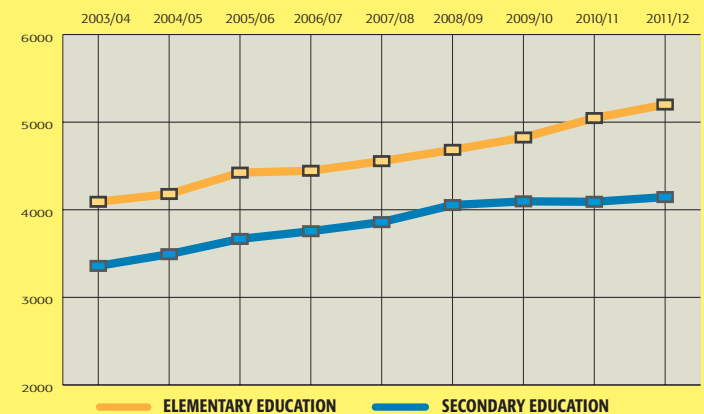

Trends in the number of teachers in public schools



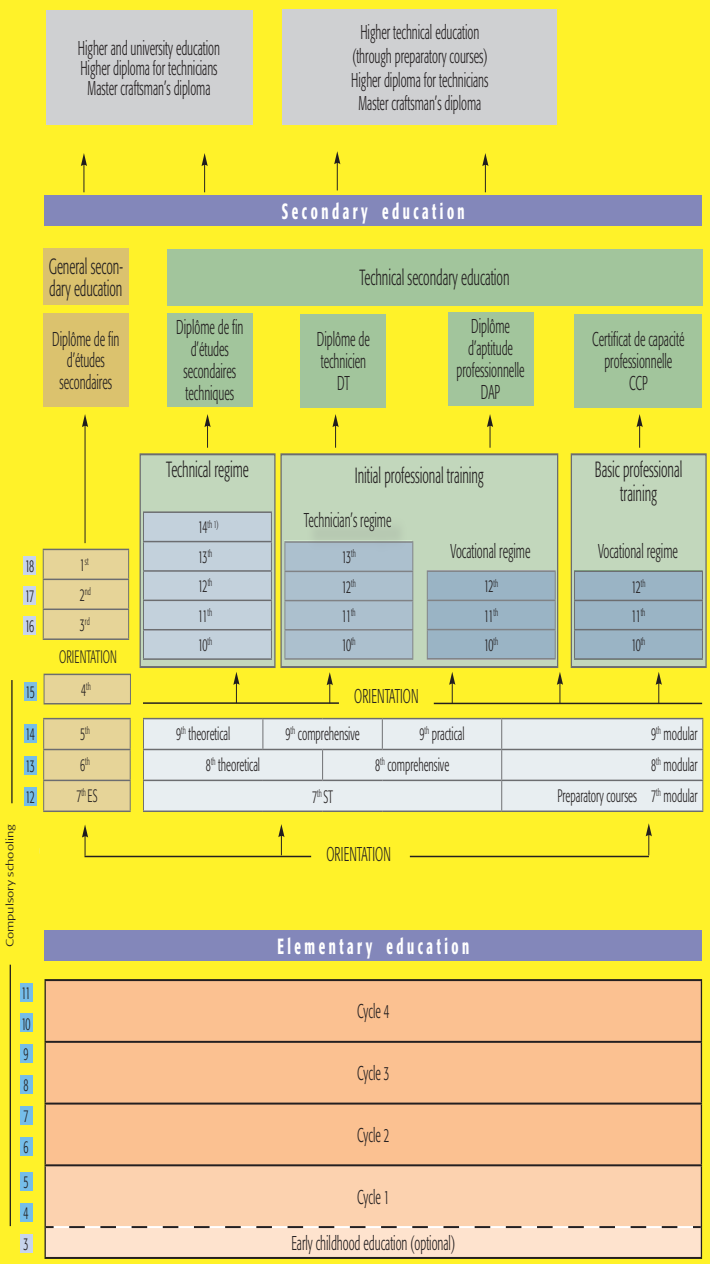

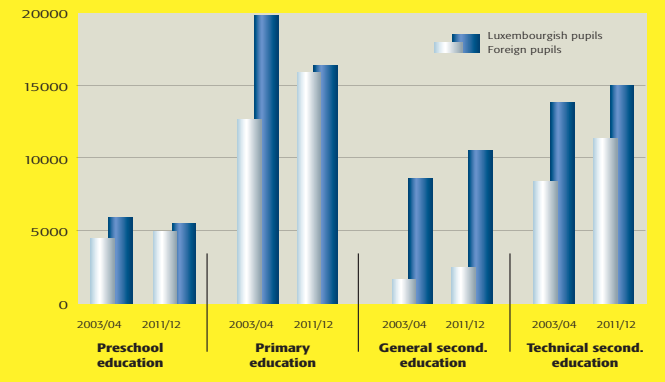

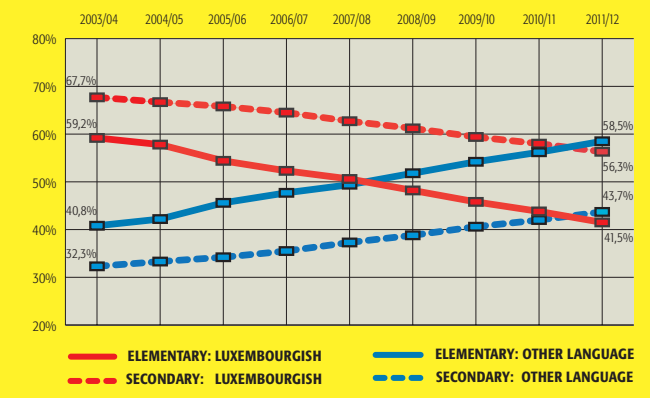

Distribution of Luxembourgish and foreign pupils

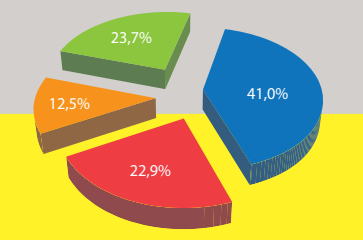


Mother tongue
